How The CRA Loophole Could Save Taxpayers Billions

The American Action Forum (@AAF) released a new infographic detailing a loophole in the Congressional Review Act (CRA) which allows Congress to repeal regulations beyond the 60 legislative day limit. The loophole exists for those regulations in which Federal Agencies did not formally submit a report to Congress. According to AAF research, there are at least five regulations, which total \$24 billion in regulatory costs, that could be affected by these loopholes in the CRA.

WHAT IS IT?

A loophole that might allow Congress to repeal regulations dating back to the *beginning of the Obama Administration*

A report must be submitted to Congress and to the Comptroller General
