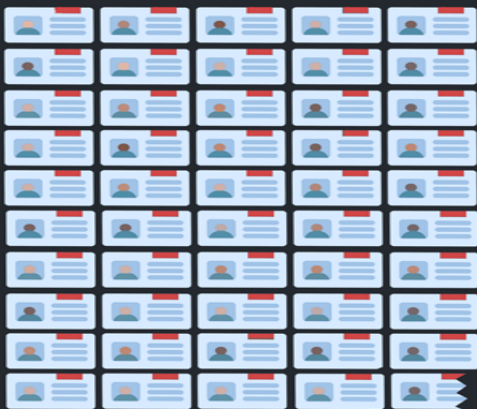


## THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF STATE-SPONSORED WORK VISAS
