# The Historic Nature of the Regulatory Slowdown

Today the American Action Forum released a new infographic examining the historic nature of the current regulatory slowdown. According to AAF analysis, since Trump took office, the White House has released only 8 percent of the historical volume of regulation and has only finalized \$33 million in costs, compared to an average of \$26 billion per year (from 2005 – 2017).

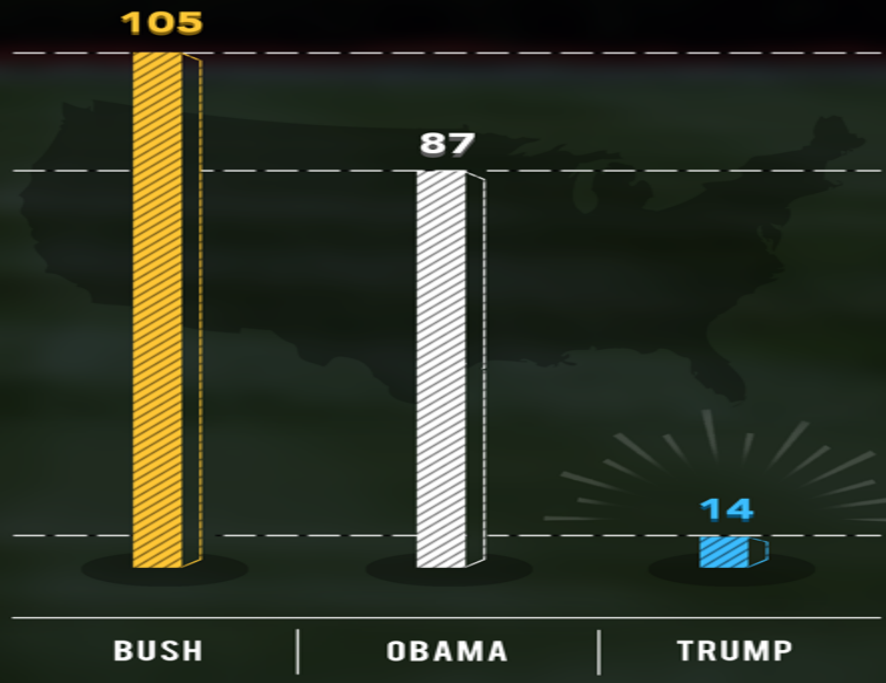

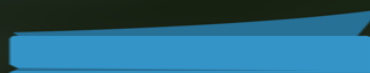
