THE SOCIAL VALUE OF EMPLOYER-SPONSORED HEALTH INSURANCE

The Total Social Value

Employer-sponsored insurance provides significant value to beneficiaries and taxpayers far beyond the cost of the tax subsidy. ESI generates around \$1.5 trillion annually in social value.

The Breakdown



\$400-\$500 BILLION

in employer profits and tax revenue, net of the cost of the tax exemption



\$200 BILLION

in reduced reliance on subsidized government insurance

\$800-\$900 BILLION

.5 TRILLION

in private surplus to Americans receiving health care



\$40 BILLION

in reduced uncompensated care of the uninsured
