



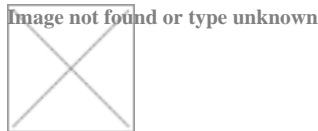

AAF Celebrates National Play-Doh Day

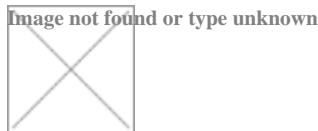
SEPTEMBER 16, 2014

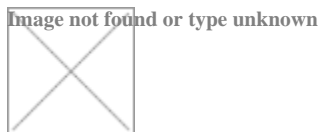
Gumby's feeling a bit flattened by the crushing burden of the \$634 billion in regulatory red tape imposed by the Obama Administration.

This Play-Doh dramatization depicts the march of 40,000 Keystone XL jobs into the United States alongside the pipeline.

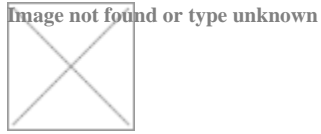


A new take on the traditional bar graph shows the breakdown of where kids would fall if the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) was not renewed.

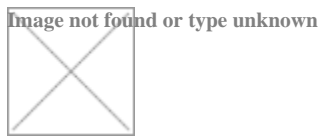
Glitch – The ACA-Created “Family Glitch”
